

## Supergroup 1: Blue Collar Communities

The members of this supergroup can be found all across the UK with areas of concentration around the North-East, South Wales and cities within Scotland and the Midlands. The supergroup comprises of 3 groups, 1a (3 subgroups), 1b (2 subgroups) and 1c (3 subgroups). There are 14 wards that have all their output areas classified in this supergroup including Creggan South, Creggan Central, Greystone, East, Ballycolman, Farranshane, and Whiterock in Northern Ireland, Thornley and Wheatley Hill, Edward and Prior in the North-East, Pembroke: Monkton, Gwynfi and Green Lane in Wales and Viewpark in Scotland. - Age 65+

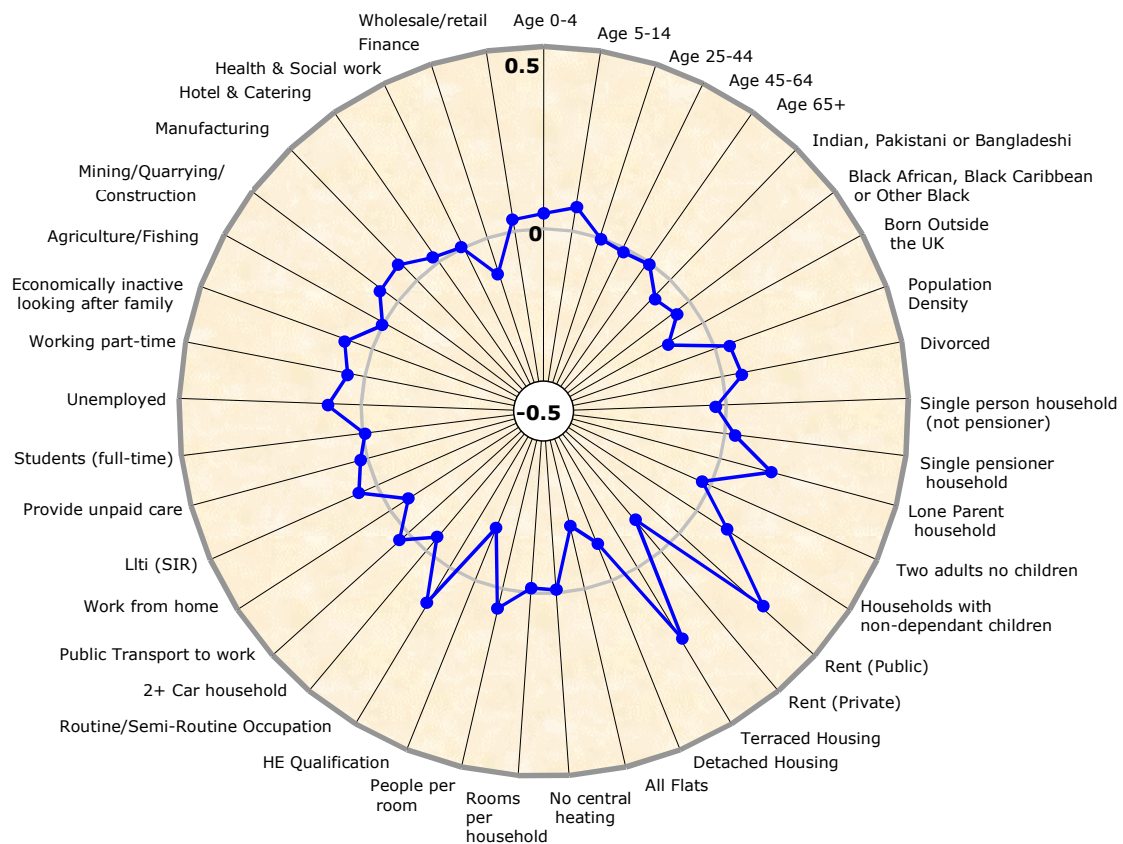
- Agriculture/Fishing employment

### Supergroup 1

Range-standardised difference from the UK mean. Positive values show an above average level of the population and negative values show a below average level.



1 For a variable to be 'far below average' it must have a difference of more than 0.15 below the UK mean  
 2 For a variable to be 'close to the average' it must have a difference of 0.015 either below or above the UK mean  
 3 For a variable to be 'far above average' it must have a difference of more than 0.15 above the UK mean
